

Borrowing aids

You have borrowed one or more aids from Hjälpmedelscentralen. During the period of loan, you are responsible for the continuous maintenance and cleaning of the aid(s). The aid is lent out as a personal loan and you are not allowed to pass it on to another person. If the aid is not properly taken care of, you may be obliged to return it and, in some circumstances, have to pay damages. You are not allowed to change fixed settings, nor to rebuild the aid. You are only allowed to use the aid in the way you have been instructed to do so. If you use it in any other way, you or your parent/guardian will be responsible if there is an accident.

Aids must be returned when they are no longer needed, within the agreed period of time, or if the person moves to another county. Aids that are broken or old must also be returned.

When aids are no longer needed, you must return them in very clean condition to:

Your nearest healthcare centre (*vårdcentral*) or to the municipality's rehabilitation unit.

In some municipalities, the municipality's rehab unit can, for a fee, pick up aids at home, contact the municipality to find out if it is possible.
